Visit by Kevin Donahue, Deputy Mayor for Public Safety and Justice

Grant Request from Iona Senior Services

Iona will present a request for a grant from ANC3B of \$856 for a portable speaker and "PocketTalker" assistive devices for residents with limited hearing to use when they are participating in Iona activities.

Resolution on Proposed Legislation to Ban Gas-Powered Leaf Blowers (H22-0234)

The legislation would prohibit use of gas-powered leaf blowers or sale of gas-powered leaf blowers for use in the District, starting in 2022 (<https://legiscan.com/DC/text/B22-0234/2017>). At the December 14 public meeting, Quiet Clean DC gave a presentation supporting the legislation and took questions on the proposal.
