## **Administrative**

**Treasurer's Report.** Brian Cohen presented the treasurer's report. It stated a beginning balance of \$23,286.26 for the month of July and August. ## **Results from Special Election to Fill Vacancy for ANC 3B02**

Gottlieb Simon announced the results of the special election:

- Jackie Blumenthal, 47 votes
- Florence Knauf, 23 votes
- Matt VanderGoot, 9 votes

Two ballots given out were incorrect but it was determined that those two ballots would not have affected the outcome of the election. As such, Jackie Blumenthal was declared the winner.

Commissioner Lane presented a resolution declaring the vacancy filled by Jackie Blumenthal. It was seconded and passed 3-0.

Ms. Blumenthal will arrange to be sworn in by Councilmember Mary Cheh and then will officially begin her duties as Commissioner for ANC 3B-02.

## **Adjournment**

Commissioner Lane asked for a motion to adjourn. A motion was so presented, seconded and passed. The meeting adjourned at 8:40. The next meeting will be held October 8 at 7 PM at Guy Mason.
