Resolution Regarding Removing Class A Licenses from the Moratorium Renewal Petition (with Rite Aid managers in attendance to take questions)

The ANC is weighing a request from Rite Aid asking us to amend our petition to the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (submitted in December), which seeks to renew the moratorium on issuing new liquor licenses in Glover Park so that the freeze on licenses would apply only to new retail liquor stores (Class A), taverns (Class T) and nightclubs (Class N). With our moratorium in place and due to other District-wide regulations about the proximity of establishments that sell off-premises alcohol, Rite Aid is unable to obtain a license to sell alcohol. Pearson's and Wide World of Wines both have Class A licenses. (CVS could not get a liquor license because it is allowed only one in the District and already has one at another store, not because of proximity laws as previously indicated.) Last month the ANC opened a 30-day comment period so that residents could react to the Rite Aid request. Comments are being taken until February 11. Your input is welcome at this meeting.

Discussion of Ward 3 and District Response to Snowzilla

We are interested in hearing reactions to storm management and snow clean-up efforts and suggestions about what could have been done better. The District worked closely with ANCs throughout the city during the storm and afterward and we would like to report back on how residents feel the process worked.
