**Approval of Agenda**

**Grant Request from Iona Senior Services**

Iona will present a request for a grant from ANC3B of \$856 for a portable speaker and “PocketTalker” assistive devices for residents with limited hearing to use when they are participating in Iona activities.

**Visit by Kevin Donahue, Deputy Mayor for Public Safety and Justice**

Mr. Donahue will make a brief presentation and allow time for questions. The agencies reporting to him include: DMV, DPW, MPD, Fire and EMS, Homeland Security and Emergency Management, Corrections, Forensic Sciences, Chief Medical Examiner, Unified Communications (911 and 311), Victim Services, DC National Guard, Human Resources, Office of the Chief Technology Officer, General Services, Contracting and Procurement, Disability Rights, and Human Rights. One item Mr. Donahue plans to discuss is implementation of the Neighborhood Engagement Achieves Results (NEAR) Act, which was the subject of a presentation at the ANC3B January public meeting.

**Resolution on Proposed Legislation to Ban Gas-Powered Leaf Blowers (B22-0234)**

The legislation would prohibit use of gas-powered leaf blowers or sale of gas-powered leaf blowers for use in the District, starting in 2022 (<https://legiscan.com/DC/text/B22-0234/2017>). At the December 14 ANC3B meeting, Quiet Clean DC gave a presentation supporting the legislation and took questions on the proposal. ANC3B also opened a public comment period on the legislation and will vote on a resolution calling for a Council hearing and supporting the proposed bill.
