DDOT is launching a "Rock Creek Far West Livability Study" focusing on recommendations for improving transportation safety in the area and assuring safe movement for residents and visitors. The study will cover all of ANC3B. The boundaries are Massachusetts Avenue, Whitehaven Parkway, Archbold Parkway, Foundry Branch Valley Park, the Potomac River, and the DC/Maryland line.
