### Police Report

#### **Resolution to support stipulated license for Laliguras restaurant at 2334 Wisconsin**

The resolution will recommend that when Laliguras applies to the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board for a liquor license at its new location, the Board should issue the license without waiting the usual 45-days for a "placard" about the application to be posted at the restaurant.

#### **Presentation and vote on application #20009 for variance to add deck at 2103 Huidekoper PI**

Maggie and Mark McCrone applied to the Bureau of Zoning Adjustment to build a rear deck that means higher lot occupancy than allowed by zoning. They are seeking ANC support for the variance.

#### **Presentation on Grant Request from Glover Park-Burleith Farmers' Market**

Community Foodworks, the non-profit organization that manages our local farmers' market, is seeking a grant of \$2,459.25 from the ANC to purchase two new canopy tents, 10 folding chairs, flyers, signage, reusable tote bags, and stickers for vehicles to promote support for the market.

#### **Letter supporting application to Commission on Arts and Humanities for outdoor art project**

Janel Leppin is a local weaver applying to the city for a Public Art Building Communities grant to support her proposed project in Glover Park. She will present her proposal and ask for ANC support.

#### **Presentation on free mediation services available from Community Mediation DC**

Lauren Javins will discuss how individuals can make use of the free services offered by Community Mediation to have a trained mediator hear disputes and assist in resolving conflicts.

#### **Letter to DC Council RE proposed On-Site Services bill (B23-0180)**

The Council introduced the bill in March that would require apartment landlords of buildings with 20 or more units to provide office space for on-site social workers and offer support services in the building if at least 30% of the units are leased to residents receiving housing assistance such as vouchers. The Council scheduled a hearing July 11 at 10 am. The Commission will consider adopting an official position on the legislation to submit in writing as part of the hearing record.
