Presentation from DC Office of Human Rights (OHR)

Ajan Brown of OHR will speak about the work of the agency and the important protections the District offers for vulnerable populations, including rights related to housing, public spaces, employment and educational institutions.

Response to Breadsoda request to extend hours on outdoor patio at 2233 Wisconsin Avenue

At the June meeting, Breadsoda presented a request to serve food and beverages on the patio till later in the evenings. The Commission announced a 30-day public comment period and will vote on a resolution about an amended settlement agreement with Breadsoda.

Request from Glover Park Main Street for Support of Application for Banner Installation

Kate Dean is seeking ANC 3B support for an application to DDOT to install “Glover Park” banners on DDOT street light poles on Wisconsin Avenue in the Glover Park commercial area.

Grant Request from Feed the Family Pantry

The International Women’s Democracy Center--a 501(c)3 organization--is requesting a \$2,500 grant for a laptop computer, printer, and compostable bags for their new Feed the Family Pantry at Van Ness, which offers residents who are struggling with food insecurity the opportunity to get groceries, toiletries, and household cleaning items.
