Police Report

Presentation by Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) Director Gabriel Robinson

Director Robinson will speak about current DMV services and initiatives, and take questions from the public.

Discussion with WMATA and DDOT about improved Metrobus service to ANC3B area

WMATA and DDOT staff will talk about the recent changes in local Metrobus services, including restoring D2 weekday service to pre-COVID levels on weekdays, effective Sunday, May 29. The D2 is now operating every 10 to 12 minutes in morning peak hours. Other changes were made in the N2/N4 and 33 buses, and some other Metrobus routes in the area. The staff members will take questions and comments, and discuss potential future adjustments in local bus services.

Presentation by Mike Arthur about Wingo’s application for entertainment endorsement at 2218 Wisconsin

Announcement of Public Comment Period on Possible Medical Marijuana Dispensary in Glover Park

Nature’s Charm LLC made a presentation to the ANC3B April meeting and is awaiting notification of whether the organization has been selected as a potential awardee for the local MMD (decision to be announced June 17). If selected, they would operate from the site now occupied by Laliguras restaurant at 2232 Wisconsin Avenue, and the ANC would need to gather public comments and adopt a position at the July 14 Public Meeting in order to make the August 8 deadline for comments in the next phase of the process.

Follow-up Discussion of bike lane options and other safety improvements on New Mexico/Tunlaw

ANC3B Chairman Brian Turmail said at the ANC3B May meeting that the Commission was planning to adopt a resolution at the July 14 ANC meeting about DDOT’s new designs for the corridor north of Calvert Street, after gathering public comments. DDOT initially presented the new designs at the April 14 ANC meeting and invited ANC and public feedback, as part of the Community Engagement process, before the agency identifies a definite proposal to put forward in a formal Notice of Intent and announce a public comment period. DDOT is currently working on revising engineering designs to improve safety at crosswalks and intersections on the corridor, and also reviewing public comments to date. The ANC would like to hear any additional comments.
