Consideration of Wingo’s Application for a Game-of-Skill Endorsement on its Liquor License

The DC Council has approved emergency legislation to allow establishments with liquor licenses to install a game of skill called Dragon’s Ascent from which players can win cash. DC Office of Attorney General (OAG) has ruled that Dragon’s Ascent is a game of skill rather than a game of chance. (A game of chance would be considered a gambling game and therefore illegal in the District.) The Commission will vote on whether to file a protest with the ABRA against allowing installation of the game. See www.anc3b.com for OAG’s ruling, the legislation, and other relevant details.

Vote to waive ANC3B bylaws to allow public meetings and voting without convening in person

As the city adjusts to the threat of COVID-19, the Mayor is discouraging non-essential public meetings. Some area public schools are also being closed to avoid contributing to community spread. On the chance that it may not be possible to conduct some future ANC public meetings as usual, the Commission will vote on temporarily waiving provisions in the ANC3B by-laws that require holding all public meetings in person, as well as requirements for Commissioners to be present in order to be counted in a quorum and to cast official vote. That would allow for community conference calls and votes on matters at such “virtual meetings” even if they cannot all be in the same space in person.
