Resolution Regarding DDOT Decision to Install a Traffic Signal at Observatory Circle and Massachusetts Avenue

ANC3B has long supported lifting the no left turn at rush hours from outbound Massachusetts Avenue onto Observatory Circle to allow access to Wisconsin Avenue and Glover Park during rush hours. A DDOT study supports both the need to lift the no left turn restrictions and the necessity of installing a traffic signal to regulate traffic at the intersection.

Letter to DC Council Requesting Increased Per Pupil Funding for School Year 2017-18

The Mayor's budget proposes cuts in DCPS per pupil funding. ANC3B will consider sending a letter urging the Council to provide as much or more funding per pupil as in 2016-17.
