Police Report

Presentation by FEMS Captain Michael Carroll about safety in fires and emergencies

Request for letter of support for new gym at British International School, 3300 Whitehaven Street
Construction of the gym is a "Modification of Consequence" to the original Planned Unit Development (PUD) agreement with the community. Commissioner Blumenthal has consulted with Commissioner Elizabeth Miller of ANC2E which is supporting the proposal. The property owner is considering a second phase of development, a proposal to add 278 residential units at the rear of the property abutting the Georgetown Safeway and Rock Creek Park. The second phase would be a "Modification of Significance" so the application for that project is expected to require a full hearing before the Zoning Commission with community input before formal approval.

Presentation on DDOT’s new process for requesting Traffic Safety Investigations (TSI) via DC 311
DDOT Community Engagement Specialist for Ward 3 Christian Piñero will provide updates on TSI process.

Discussion of design of bike lanes DDOT presented for New Mexico and Tunlaw Road north of Calvert
At the April 14 ANC3B public meeting, DDOT gave a slide presentation including maps, renderings, and other diagrams for review by the ANC and members of the public as part of the Community Engagement process, before DDOT develops any final plans or issues a Notice of Intent and opens a formal public comment period. The meeting will provide time for questions, comments, and suggestions for adjustments to the design.

Resolution to Support Language in FY2023 DC Budget for Expansion of Stoddert Elementary School
Councilmember Cheh, Ward 3 Board of Education member Ruth Wattenberg, and the Stoddert PTO and LSAT are proposing budget language calling for planned renovations at Stoddert to provide for adding a third story to the school as enrollment increases, and avoid sending local students to a school outside the neighborhood.
