Police Report

Request regarding speeding on 3800 block of Davis Place NW

Resolution Regarding Liquor License for Trader Joe's at 2101 Wisconsin Avenue NW

Trader Joe's is planning to open in the former Holiday Inn development in late 2018 or early 2019. It seeks a Class B liquor license to sell beer and wine during the standard store hours of 8 a.m. to 10 p.m. daily. A comment period was opened at the ANC's October meeting.

Resolution Regarding Zoning Application for Proposed Domino's (BZA Case No. 19600)

To qualify for a special exception under the zoning code that permits fast-food restaurants in the Glover Park commercial area, Domino's is seeking approval for variances from two criteria: that 1) trash receptacles have a brick enclosure (The enclosure is wooden); and 2) that fast-food operations be separated from residential zones by an alley or a distance of 25 feet (The parking lot is zoned residential). The proposed site is the south half of the former El Salvador Consulate at Calvert Center, 2330 Wisconsin Avenue, which already has two fast-food operations, Chipotle and Bruegger's. A comment period was opened at the ANC's September meeting.

Grant Request from Hardy Middle School Parent Teacher Organization (PTO)

Jason Orlando, Treasurer of the Hardy PTO, will present a request for a \$2,500 grant to use for purchasing books and other library materials to help bring the school's library up to date.

Presentation Regarding the Downtown DC Public Restroom Initiative

Marcia Bernbaum, People for Fairness Coalition, will discuss this initiative and Bill 22-0223, the Public Restroom Facility Installation and Promotion Act of 2017 introduced in the DC Council.
