Police Report

Resolution in Support of Stipulated Entertainment License for Laliguras at 2332 Wisconsin Avenue NW

In September the ANC voted to approve a Settlement Agreement including new open hours and hours of entertainment for Laliguras, reducing the hours somewhat from the owner's request. and in the same resolution supported a stipulated license to allow Laliguras to operate under the new terms immediately. The Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration requires a separate resolution from the ANC approving the stipulated license.

Presentation of Request from Stoddert PTO for \$2,500 grant to help purchase tent for outdoor learning

DDOT presentation of new traffic analysis and updated preliminary concept designs for potential improvements to bike lanes on New Mexico/Tunlaw/37th Street corridor

DDOT's consultant on the project has conducted traffic analysis on the segments of the corridor in ANC3B, ANC3D, and ANC2E. Their findings will be presented at the meeting, including implications for various alternatives and some new preliminary concept designs being considered for bike lanes. There will also be time for questions and answers.

Updates and Information

- Stop Sign Camera at 37th and Whitehaven: After September 10 site visit, DDOT installed new signs approaching the camera and committed to providing the community 2-week notice that an automated traffic enforcement device is being activated, before any citations are issued.
- 2020 Annual Visitor Parking effective date extended until January 15, 2022, per CM Cheh's request, while DDOT works further on ParkDC permit program.
- October 15 deadline for seniors to apply for exemption from DPW snow shoveling requirement and fines.
- COVID-19 public health emergency is expiring October 12 which means local utilities will be able to resume disconnections. The utilities still have to give 60-day notice before a disconnection and there are other protections for ratepayers. A utility cannot disconnect service if a customer has entered a payment plan to catch up on overdue bills. Residents should be in touch with OPC for details: opc-dc.gov 202-727-3071
