**Resolution Supporting DDOT’s Proposal to Install a Micromobility Corral
on the 3700 Block of Fulton St. NW**

WHEREAS, in January 2021 Mayor Muriel Bowser set a goal to reduce reliance on automobiles and provide safe infrastructure for pedestrians and alternative transportation methods also known as micromobility;

WHEREAS, in September 2023 the City Council of the District of Columbia passed the Electric Bicycle Incentive Program Amendment Act of 2023 to increase use of electric bicycles in the District of Columbia as an alternative transportation method to reduce reliance on automobiles;

WHEREAS, the use of micromobility devices including privately owned and shared electric scooters, electric bicycles, and traditional bicycles has steadily risen in the District of Columbia;

WHEREAS, the increase of micromobility use in the District of Columbia combined with a lack of adequate on and off street parking has led to partial and full blockage of sidewalks and devices left blocking building access;

WHEREAS, ANC 3B recognizes the need to provide adequate public parking areas for micromobility devices to support and encourage the use of these devices and keep sidewalks clear;
