RESOLUTION TO INSTITUTE ONE-SIDE ZONE 3 RESIDENT-ONLY  
PARKING ON HALL PLACE, W PLACE, AND THE PORTION OF  
TUNLAW ROAD BETWEEN 37TH STREET AND THE DEAD END

Whereas, Hall Place, W Place and the portion of Tunlaw Road N.W. between 37th Street and the dead end are located in an area of Glover Park, with no other adjacent streets accessible for resident-zoned parking;

Whereas, this area abuts the commercial area of Wisconsin Avenue and the three streets are heavily used for parking by visitors to the restaurants, stores and services in Glover Park;

Whereas, despite the availability of ample off-street parking for non-resident visitors in parking lots located in the commercial area of Wisconsin Avenue, these non-resident visitors are instead parking on these nearby residential streets;

Whereas, many residents of these streets area have no off-street parking and evening parking is extremely difficult to find because of the many spots occupied by non-resident vehicles;

Whereas, all three streets in this area already have Zone 3 RPP parking;

Whereas, an overwhelming majority of residents of Hall Place signed and submitted to DDOT a petition in favor of instituting One-Side Zone 3 Resident Only parking on that street;

Whereas, if Hall Place were to get One-Side Zone 3 Resident Only parking, visitors could then be pushed onto W Place and the portion of Tunlaw Road between 37th Street and the dead end in this closed-off area with no other adjacent streets for parking;

Therefore, ANC3B requests that DDOT designate Hall Place, W Place and the portion of Tunlaw Road N.W. between 37th Street and the dead end for One-Side Zone 3 Resident Only parking, and that the designation occur on all three streets simultaneously *and be in force 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.*

Proposed and approved <sup>as amended</sup> by a vote of 4 to 0 on December 13, 2012, at a duly-scheduled meeting of ANC3B at which a quorum was present.
