**Resolution Requesting a 90-Day Extension of the Glover Park Moratorium to Allow
the Community to Comment on Whether or Not It Should be Continued**

Whereas, the Glover Park Moratorium has been in place since 1994, when it was deemed necessary to limit the number of liquor licenses in the small Glover Park commercial area due to serious disruptions of the peace, order and quiet;

Whereas, the Moratorium has been renewed several times since then and amended to reflect the changing nature of the Glover Park commercial area and the interests of the surrounding community;

Whereas, the Moratorium that is currently in place restricts only the issuance of liquor licenses for taverns and clubs (Class CT, CN, CX, DN, DT, DX), i.e., establishments that are not required to serve food along with alcohol service;

Whereas, the Moratorium was set to expire on February 10, 2022, but ANC3B was not notified about this until February 9, 2022; previously the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration ("ABRA") had diligently advised the ANC of the expiration date several months in advance and that was our expectation;

Whereas, the Glover Park community has been consulted and involved in every previous iteration of the Moratorium and ANC3B has made every effort to reflect their concerns in its petitions to the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board ("the Board") regarding the continued existence of the Glover Park Moratorium;

Therefore, ANC3B requests that the Board issue an Emergency Rule to allow a 90-day extension of the Glover Park Moratorium so that the ANC can fulfill its responsibility to inform and consult the residents of Glover Park, come to an agreement regarding the Moratorium that reflects the consensus of the community, and submit an official request to either continue or cancel the Moratorium.

This resolution was approved by a vote of 4-0 at a duly noticed ANC3B public meeting on February 10, 2022, at which a quorum was present. (Three of the five members constitute a quorum.)

By this vote, the Commission also designates Commissioner Blumenthal or her designee to represent the Commission on all matters pertaining to this resolution.
