Police Report

Presentation on requested changes to liquor license for Bourbon/Rosebud at 2348 Wisconsin Avenue

Owner Bill Thomas will present his plans for a new establishment where Bourbon used to be and talk about his request for changes in the liquor license, including outside alcohol service in the front and rear on both the first floor and second floor, as well as a rooftop bar/eating area.

Presentation on application to Board of Zoning Adjustment for a special exception at 3764 Beecher Street

Peter Roushdy and Kelly Franklin have applied to the BZA for a special exception to construct a rear deck that would extend 11.7 feet from the back of the house (leading to coverage of 48.9% of the lot rather than 40% allowed as a matter of right in an R-3 zone). Other zoning requirements including a 20-foot rear setback would still be met.

Vote on letter of support for renewing city grant to Glover Park Clean Team for FY2020

Will Avila and Charlie Curtis will review their past year of service with Glover Park's Clean Team and request the Commission's support for them to continue as the local Clean Team for another year.

Grant request from Glover Park Alliance for \$2,500 to support Main Street application

Chris Wainwright will present the application for a grant to help pay for a consultant to guide the Alliance through the process of applying to receive a Main Street grant from the city for improving the Glover Park commercial area and to train volunteers in fundraising and outreach skills.
