Discussion of Funding for Local Public Schools in Mayor's Proposed FY2020 Budget

At the end of March, Mayor Bowser released her proposed budget for the coming fiscal year (beginning September 30, 2019), which is now being considered by the DC Council. While many schools are shown as receiving increased funding compared to the current fiscal year, some would face significant reductions in education funds per pupil. Council Chairman Mendelson has stated that the overall funding is not adequate to keep up with inflation or maintain and improve the quality of education. Ruth Wattenberg, Ward 3 member of the District's State Board of Education, will speak about the proposed budget focusing on implications for local schools. DC Deputy Mayor for Education Paul Kihn will also participate, as well as representatives from the parent teacher organizations at Stoddert Elementary School, Hardy Middle School and Wilson High School about proposed funding levels and funding needs.
