Police Report

DC Department of Public Works (DPW) Plans for Fall and Winter Services

Celeste Duffie, DPW Community Relations Specialist, will provide information on DPW plans for fall leaf collection, snow shoveling, holiday greens disposal, and other programs.

Resolution on DDOT Guidelines for Small Cell Technology

DDOT's Public Space Committee is holding a hearing on October 15 and proposing to vote on its proposed guidelines for "small cell" antennas and related equipment to support 5G communications in the District. ANCs and others are invited to submit testimony on the proposal.

Resolution on Clean Energy DC Omnibus Act of 2018 (B22-0904) proposal before the DC Council

Councilmember Cheh scheduled an initial hearing October 9 about proposed legislation to raise renewable energy standards in the District, support LEED certified (energy efficient) buildings, provide additional funds to support research and assist with energy efficiency improvements for low income residents, and coordinate with nearby states on establishing "carbon tax" programs. CM Cheh requests written testimony for the record that can also be submitted to Kenyan McDuffie's Committee on Business and Economic Development, which is also supposed to take up the bill so it can move to the full Council for a vote by the end of the year. CM Cheh's Legislative Director Nicole Rentz spoke about the proposed bill at the ANC3B September meeting.
